She ensured that the remaining shelter residents, as well as the shelter staff were safe. She oversaw the shelter cleaning and made sure it mitigated per CDC and state Health Department requirements.

Because of Tracy's exposure, she was quarantined, but still remained in contact with her staff at the Southwestern Pennsylvania Human Services program.

Tracy's leadership has lead the shelter staff and residents through this unprecedented crisis, and has kept the staff and residents feeling safe, all while ensuring the homeless of our community still have a safe and clean place to find respite.
